\*\*In order to receive full credit for Concord's BGEN 210 - Introduction to Computers in Business course, student must complete CS 116, 118, 120 and 125 (8 credit hours) at Southern. Should the student decide to take the BGEN 210 at Concord, he/she must take a minimum 3 credit hour Computer Information Systems (CS) course to meet Southern's general education computer literacy requirement for the associate degree. Any additional CS hours taken at Southern will count against the maximum 72 hours applicable toward the 128 hour semester hours required for the baccalaureate degree at Concord College.
