



SUBJECT: The Dean's List of Students; Graduation With Honors Status

7. RESPONSIBILITIES AND PROCEDURES

- A. At the conclusion of each semester, the Vice President Student Services shall prepare a list of full-time students who have maintained a 3.25 or better grade point average.
- B. A student who earns a minimum grade point average of 3.25 while attempting and completing twelve (12) or more credit hours during a semester shall be placed on the Dean's List for the following semester and shall be recognized in writing by the Division Chair.
- C. Students completing requirements for an associate degree or certificate program with a minimum of 3.40 cumulative grade point average are eligible to graduate with honors. Developmental courses in the less than 100 level series are not used in the calculation of the graduation grade point average. Students can complete graduation requirements during the fall and spring semester. Southern has graduation only once a year in May. The grades received by a student during the fall semester will be the final grades used to calculate graduation grade point average for both fall and spring graduates.
