The course is designed to introduce the primary responsibilities of a sterile processing technician including practical application of learned concepts and procedures. Experience in instrument identification, preparation, storage and distribution of supplies and equipment. 400 clinical hours are required. The class will prepare the student to take the national certification exam.

Any student working in the Central Sterile Supply Department of a hospital and needs to take the certification exam to maintain their employment may take only the AH 130, AH 135, and AH 160. All other students must take the required courses for the certification program.
