### Purpose

The program will prepare the student to take exams through American Health Information Management Association (AHIMA) for Clinical Coding Specialist (CCS) and Registered Health Information Technician (RHIT). Health information management is the practice of acquiring, analyzing, and protecting digital and traditional medical information vital to providing quality patient care. The health information management student will be highly trained in the latest information management technology applications and understand the workflow in any healthcare provider organization from large hospital systems to the private physician practice.
